

#### ALABAMA GARDENER'S CALENDAR FOR DECEMBER

**FRUITS AND NUTS**—Plant young pecan and other deciduous fruit trees and grapes. Select bud wood. Start dormant pruning of established fruits. Protect all young trees from rabbit damage by placing wire around the base of the tree. Apply dormant oil spays for scale.

**LAWNS**—Control wild garlic, chickweed, Poa annua, dandelion, and other weeds. Read label on each package of weed killer used.

**ROSES**—Add plants to rose garden. Mulch all plantings.

**ANNUALS AND PERENNIALS**—Plant hardy annual seed without delay. Have you tried violas?

**BULBS**—Continue spring bulb planting.

**SHRUBS**—Planting is still the main activity but delay in case of freezing weather.

MISCELLANEOUS—Shrubs, trees, and indoor plants make excellent gifts.
