
As mentioned in the AC meeting today, we need your help getting this program off the ground. Attached is an invitation from Bethany O'Rear, Regional Agent, to join our effort.

ROASTED PEACH PRESERVES

from the kitchen of Kate Vogel, Master Gardener

This is a good recipe to use up peaches that are getting overripe

3 pounds of peaches Sugar as needed Zest & juice of 1 lemon

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F.
- 2. Slice peaches in half but do not peel.
- 3. If they are freestone, remove the seed. If not, leave the seed in.
- 4. Place peel side down on a cookie sheet.
- 5. Roast at 350°F for 30 minutes.
- 6. Remove the peels and seeds and mash with a fork or potato masher on the cookie sheet.
- 7. Continue roasting at 250°F for 2-3 hours.
- 8. Stir occasionally after an hour.
- Add lemon.
- 10. Taste for sweetness and add sugar as desired. It's really sweet with very little sugar.
- 11.Can as usual.


