It is expected to be sunny and in the 60's, so light layers are suggested. If you have already filled out the waiver, you do not need to fill it out again. Here is the directions and info:

The following is from Jessica Shumate, Director:

There is no physical address for Ebenezer Swamp Ecological Preserve, but you can use google maps for directions: <a href="Ebenezer Swamp">Ebenezer Swamp</a>. It is located on the corner of County Road 24 and Stage Coach Rd. If you are driving from I-65N: You will take the Shelby County Airport Exit and take a left at the light. Then take a right at the next light onto Smokey Rd. About a mile down the road, you'll see the County Road 24 sign and take that left. Less than half a mile, the Preserve is located on the right side. Stage Coach Rd is a dirt road, but you can park alongside the road and walk past the gate. I will meet everyone at the picnic tables and there are restrooms available on-site. I suggest bringing water, mask, a light snack, and sunscreen. We will be walking along a boardwalk, but it is always a good idea to wear shoes with a good grip and that might get dirty. 

### The Best Crack Cake

from the kitchen of Heidee Vansant, Master Gardener

#### INGREDIENTS:

#### **FOR THE CAKE:**

- 1 box Duncan Hines yellow cake mix
- ¼ cup brown sugar
- ¼ cup white sugar
- 1 box vanilla pudding instant mix
- 2 teaspoons cinnamon
- 4 eaas
- 34 cup water
- 34 cup oil
- ½ cup white wine (really any kind, but I always use my go-to pinot grigio)

#### I FOR THE GLAZE:

- 1 stick butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/4 cup white wine

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F.
- 2. Mix the above ingredients by hand or hand mixer.
- 3. Grease a Bundt pan VERY well. (I use butter or Pam Baking Spray)
- 4. Pour into pan and bake for 1 hour, or until a knife comes out clean.
- 5. When cake comes out of the oven...6. Melt 1 stick butter into 1 cup sugar and ¼ cup wine.
- 7. Pour over hot cake. (I poke holes in the cake to help it soak in)
- **8**. Cool.
- 9. Flip out of pan onto plate and serve (loosened the cake with a flexible spatula and shake-shake-shake and bang it to help loosen it out in one piece!)

## ALABAMA GARDENERS' CALENDAR FOR MAY

**FRUITS AND NUTS**—Continue spray program. Keep grass from around trees & strawberries. Peaches & apples can still be budded.

**SHRUBS**—Newly planted shrubs need extra care now and in coming weeks. Don't spray with oil emulsions when temperature is above 85°F. **LAWNS**—Now is the best time to start lawns from seed. Water new lawns as needed to prevent drying. Keep established lawns actively growing by watering, fertilizing, and mowing. Spray weeds in lawns with proper herbicide.

**ROSES**—Spray or dust for insects and diseases. Fertilize monthly with complete fertilizer or Rose special. Container-grown plants in flower may be planted. Prune climbing roses after the first big flush of flowering.

**ANNUALS AND PERENNIALS**—Late plantings of bedding plants still have time to produce. Watch for insects on day lilies.

**BULBS**—Summer bulbs started in containers may still be planted. Do not remove foliage from spring flowering bulbs. Do not let seed heads form on tulips and other spring flowering bulbs.

**MISCELLANEOUS**—Mulch new shrub plantings if not already done. Avoid drying out new shrub, tree, and lawn plantings.

**VEGETABLE SEED**—Plant heat-loving and tender vegetables. Start cauliflower, Brussels sprouts, and celery in cold-frame for fall garden. **VEGETABLES**—Plant tomatoes, peppers, eggplants, and sweet potatoes.
