

## **Pumpkin Pie Bars**

From the Kitchen of: Kate Vogel, Shelby County Master Gardener

1 can (29 ounces) pumpkin

1 can (12 ounces) evaporated milk

1-1/2 cups sugar

4 large eggs, room temperature

4 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice

1 package yellow or butter recipe golden cake mix

1 cup butter, melted

1 cup chopped pecans (optional)



 Preheat oven to 350°F. In a large bowl, combine the first 5 ingredients; beat on medium speed until smooth. Pour into an ungreased 13x9-inch baking pan. Sprinkle with dry cake mix. Drizzle butter over top; sprinkle with pecans.

2. Bake 50 - 60 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out

clean. Cool 1 hour on a wire rack.

Refrigerate 3 hours or overnight. Remove from refrigerator 15 minutes before serving. Cut into bars. SCMG's please remember, we need recipe contributions from <u>all</u> of YOU. Please send recipes to: scmga.email@gmail.com
