Best Blueberry Pound Cake

From the Kitchen of, Heidee Vansant, Shelby County Master Gardener

Incredibly dense and moist. Now this is what an old-fashioned pound cake should be! Just like the ones I remember at all the bake sales and at Grandmother's. Use fresh blueberries and the zest and juice of a lemon.

Ingredients:

½ cup butter

3 eggs

3½ cups all-purpose flour

2 tsp. baking powder

¼ tsp. salt

2 cups sugar

4 cups fresh blueberries

1 cup milk



How to make it:

Allow butter and eggs to stand at room temperature for 30 minutes. Meanwhile, grease a I 10-inch tube pan; set aside. In a large bowl sift together the flour, baking powder, and salt; I set aside. In a large mixing bowl beat the butter and sugar with an electric mixer on I medium speed until mixture is well combined. Beat in eggs. Stir blueberries into flour

mixture. By hand, stir blueberry mixture into butter mixture. Stir in milk just until combined. Spread batter in prepared pan. Bake in a 325°F oven for 60 to 75 minutes or until a wooden skewer inserted near center comes out clean. Cool on wire rack for 15 minutes. Loosen cake from edge of pan with a narrow metal spatula. Remove cake from pan, cool completely on wire rack.









