

- 1 lb. Sweet Potato
- 1 red onion or 2 shallots
- 1 Honey Crisp apple

Olive oil Minced Garlic Salt Honey

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 425° F.
- 2. Chop all ingredients.
- 3. Toss in sauce.
- 4. Bake 30 minutes. (I like to broil 3 minutes more to make it crispy).


