**RECIPE:** Crazy Chocolate Cake

FROM THE KITCHEN OF: Trisha Williams

Crazy Chocolate Cake is a quick and easy handed-down recipe that Trisha William's mother used to make for an after school snack. When cool, frost with Crazy Chocolate Icing or top with whipped cream and a drizzle of chocolate syrup. Serve from the pan! There are no eggs or milk in the cake. After school snacks have really changed over the years!

#### Crazy Chocolate Cake

Mix the cake right in an 8"x 8" pan (It may be easier to use a mixing bowl and then pour into the ungreased or lightly greased pan). Combine the dry ingredients:

- 11/2 cup flour
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- ¼ t. salt
- 4 Tbls. Cocoa

Make 4 dents in the dry ingredient mixture for

the following: 4 Tbls. salad oil ¼ tsp. vanilla 1 Tbls. vinegar 1 cup water Mix until well blended and bake in a preheated 350°F oven for 30 minutes.



#### Crazy Chocolate Icing

2 Tbls. butter ¼ cup cocoa 1 cup confectioner's sugar

1 Tbls. milk (more if needed)

¼ tsp. vanilla

Melt butter and stir in cocoa, place in mixing bowl. Beat in confectioner's sugar, milk, and vanilla. Beat on medium for approximately 5 minutes or until smooth. Spread on cool cake.


