
Thank you to Betsy Coley for submitting the following article for the upcoming AMGA Garden Pathyways newsletter.

Capital City Master Gardeners Association (CCMGA) continues to be involved in the development of the Montgomery Botanical Gardens (MBG) at Oak Park. CCMGA has a strong presence on the Board of Directors and our members assist in various ways, such as financial support, planning, and labor.

Recent additions to MBG are a gravel pathway and signage in the Southern Garden. (See photo.) The signs indicate how various sections will be developed.

One aspect of MBG that Master Gardeners are particularly excited about is the new greenhouse. Members have assisted in the construction of the framework. The next phase will be running various utility lines and then spreading crushed rock on the floor. After that is complete, the tables and shelves will be brought in. The covering will be added when the Master Gardeners are ready to use the greenhouse.

Most importantly the MBG board of directors will be compiling a Greenhouse Operations Plan to organize and manage the access and use of the greenhouse and insure oversight of any plant materials inside when it is placed in service.
