Upcoming Montgomery Master Gardener Classes AnnouncementPlease pass on the information below from Mallory Kelley to anyone you know who may be interested in attending the upcoming intern classes in Montgomery.

Do you love to grow fruit or vegetables or maybe flowers and herbs? If so, we would like you to consider the Master Gardener course this coming spring. The Montgomery County Extension Office is offering the Master Gardener Volunteer Program, but space is limited! Classes will be held every Thursday starting February 16th through May 4thfrom 9:00am-2:00pm

at the Montgomery County Extension Office on Atlanta Highway (the old probate office) and applications will be accepted through Friday, January 27th.

The Master Gardener Program is a nationwide Extension Education Program designed for non-professionals with interest in increasing their gardening skills and helping others with the knowledge they have gained.

The program will consist of in-class training for 12 consecutive weeks. After completing the courses, the Master Gardener interns will be expected to give 10 hours of service to the Master Gardener Helpline and 40 hours of volunteer service to Extension and/or their community in horticulture education.

Examples of volunteer efforts include: Talking to Garden Clubs, community garden projects, outdoor school projects and educational workshops just to name a few. The courses on gardening will be taught by specialist, county agents, and veteran Master Gardeners on subjects such as: Soils and Plant Nutrition, Plant Physiology, Plant Propagation, Care of Landscape Plants, Landscape Design, Lawn Care, Weed Identification, Vegetable Gardening, Herbs, Composting, and many more.

The fee associated with this class is \$150, that includes all course materials, and your lunch is provided by the Capital City Master Gardeners each week. For an application please contact the Montgomery County Extension Office at (334) 270-4133 or online at:
