LUNCH AND LEARN by Jane Mobley Butterfly Gardening in the South

How does a butterfly garden differ from a regular garden?

All design principles that are used in a regular garden should be employed in a butterfly garden with plant selection dependent on butterfly requirements.

Flower characteristics are important. Nectar flowers must be tubular because of the mouth shape of the adult. Also, flowers should have a platform shape because of the long legs of the insect. Clustered flowers arranged in the horizontal plane are good - like yarrow and Queen Anne's lace. Flowers in the daisy family are good. Fragrance is important. Color is important.
