- Poppies have long been used as a symbol of both sleep and death: sleep because of the
  opium extracted from them, and death because of their (commonly) blood-red color. In
  Greco-Roman myths, poppies were used as offerings to the dead.Poppies are used as
  emblems on tombstones to symbolize eternal sleep.
  - August Explanation: The flower for this month is the Gladiolus. It blooms in a variety of colours like red, pink, white, yellow and orange. It stands for sincerity and symbolises strength of character.
