DARK RED/PURPLE TOMATOES BURSTING WITH FLAVOR




1. **AMAZON CHOCOLATE.** Heirloom. Great flavor with sweet, wine-like overtones. Potato-leafed variety. Soft and lush with ample juice for acidity. 75 days. ** H and N favorite.




2. **BLACK KRIM.** Heirloom. Medium-sized, very dark beefsteak, with wonderfully rich flavor. From the Isle of Krim (Crimea) on the Black Sea. 80 days. Said to be the healthiest tomato. Suitable for large containers.



3. **CARBON BLACK.** Heirloom. Prolific producer of dark, purple-brown 10-14 oz fruits. Rich, complex tomato flavors. Beautiful, red with copper hints. 75 days.




4. **CHEROKEE PURPLE.** Heirloom. From Tennessee cultivated by Cherokee tribe. Very productive plants with deep red color and dark green shoulders. 80 days. Consistent taste-test champion. ** H and N favorite.




5. **CHOCOLATE STRIPES.** Heirloom. Very large plants produce well into Fall. Plentiful crop of 3-4 inch mahogany fruits with dark olive-green striping. Rich, sweet flavor. 80 days.

6. **COPIA.** Heirloom. Cross between Green Zebra and Marvel Stripe. 12-14 ounce red and yellow striped fruit with great flavor. Introduced to us by a neighbor and now a must-grow. Sweet, tangy and unique. 85-days.




7. **HILLBILLY or FLAME.** Heirloom. Huge bi-color yellow fruits with red marbling. Beautiful when sliced with rich, sweet unbelievable flavor. 80-85 days. Wait for the red marbling before picking! ** H and N favorite.



8. **YELLOW BRIMMER.** Heirloom. Beefsteak variety that yields large yellow-orange fruits with a mild, sweet, luscious flavor. Beautiful tomato. 80-days.

RED AND PINK OLD FASHIONED FAVORITES



9. **BONNIE BEST.** Heirloom variety of famed tomato originated in Union Springs, AL in 1908. THE canning tomato until WWII. Medium size fruits with big flavor for canning. Solid and meaty. 72 days.


10. **BRANDYWINE OTV.** Heirloom. Creamy, rich, almost buttery flavor. Potato-leaved variety. Sets fruit better than other Brandywines in the South. One of the best tasting tomatoes available. 72 days. **H and N favorite.

11. **FOURTH OF JULY.** Hybrid. Huge producer of red, round 2-2.5 inch tomatoes. Juicy and full of tomato flavor. Will produce all summer and long into fall. Ripens quickly, too. 49 days.

12. **MORTGAGE LIFTER.** Heirloom. People drove hundreds of miles to buy seedlings from "Radiator Charlie" in Logan, WV during the 1930s. He paid off his \$6000 mortgage with sales of these giant, red and pink, tasty heirlooms. Disease resistant. Can get very large. 82 days.

13. **1884.** Heirloom. Vigorous plants yield large 1-2 pound dark pink fruit with old-time tomato flavor. Discovered near Friendly, West Virginia in 1884.

14. **BERKELEY TIE DYE.** Heirloom. Tri-color fruits with green, yellow and red flesh. Each color has different flavor. A favorite for chefs. A spicy, sweet, tart tomato with good acid all in one. A very unique tomato. 80 days.

15. **GREEN ZEBRA.** Heirloom. Popular succulent fruits that start off pale green with dark green stripes that soften and turn yellow when ripe. A gourmet green tomato. Oodles of 1.5 to 2.5 fruits. 78 days.

CHERRY TOMATOES AND SMALL CONTAINER PLANTS



16. **SUNGOLD.** Hybrid. Huge producer of quarter-sized round, gold clusters. Sweet, rich, and tart. Garden candy! Very early 55-60 days. ** H and N fav.

17. **YELLOW PEAR.** Heirloom. Loads of 2 inch pear-shaped fruit. Very large plants with low acid levels. Great for salads or eating in the garden. 60-days. Our first heirloom tomato remains a must-plant. ** H and N favorite.

18. **PATIO PRINCESS.** Hybrid. Perfect patio container plant yields loads of tasty 2-2.5 inch fruits. Just right for medium pots. Determinate. 65 days.

19. **TINY TIM ORGANIC.** Heirloom. Dwarf cherry, grows 10-18 inches in small pots. Early producer of firm, meaty one inch fruits. Beautiful patio plant!
