1. **GROWING ORNAMENTALS:**

Includes activities with plants not grown specifically for consumption, such as flowers, shrubs, trees, lawns, etc.

Activities that represent Extension and/or the Extension Master Gardener Program. They are designed to impact the entire community (e.g., green space beautification) or a specific audience (therapeutic horticulture at a habilitation or rehabilitation center, with military veterans or adult activity center, etc.)

Subcategories for entering a report: 1. Plan/establish/maintain a garden, 2. Event prep/support/ hospitality, 3. Teaching Adults, 4. Teaching Youth, 5. Therapeutic horticulture (Optional, 6. Donations)

Includes activities with plants grown specifically for consumption, such as fruits, vegetables, herbs, etc.

They are designed to impact the entire community (e.g., community or school garden) or a specific audience (therapeutic horticulture at a habilitation or rehabilitation center, for military veterans or adult activity center, etc.)

3. CREATING & SHARING INFORMATION

Activities that represent Extension and / or the Extension Master Gardener Program. They are designed to impact the entire community (e.g., social media) or a specific audience (e.g., Helpline).

Subcategories for entering a report: 1. Researching information that educates (for presentations or media), 2. Creating materials that educate, 3. Helpline, Ask-a-MG, or garden consult

 - Subcategory = Helpline, Ask-a-MG, or garden consult
- Info. booth
 - Subcategory = Helpline, Ask-a-MG, or garden consult
- Ask-a-Master Gardener
 - Subcategory = Helpline, Ask-a-MG, or garden consult

 - Subcategory = Helpline, Ask-a-MG, or garden consult
- Facebook
 - Subcategory = Researching info. and/or Creating (depending on activity today)
- Newsletter
 - Subcategory = Researching info. and/or Creating (depending on activity today)

4. COMMUNITY PARTNER EVENTS

These events connect Extension and/or the Extension Master Gardener Program with a community partner. These are not led by and do not directly represent Extension and/or the Extension Master Gardener Program. The community partner is responsible for leading the event. These activities should have a connection to horticulture. (County Fairs, Seasonal Civic Events, Arbor Day, Habitat for Humanity house landscape Helping an organization outside of Extension)

Subcategories for entering a report: 1. Community partner event (what & who), (Optional, 2. Donations)

5. SUPPORT OTHER EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

A volunteer activity that directly assists or collaborates with Extension programs **outside of those with the Home Grounds team**. Extension Home Grounds activities include those related to reporting categories 1, 2, & 3.

Subcategories for entering a report: 1. Other Extension activities (what and who), (Optional, 2. Donations)

 - Subcategory = Community partner event (what & who)
- Chick Chain or Your Money-Your Life
 - Subcategory = Community partner event (what & who)

- Extension Office work
 - Subcategory = Community partner event (what & who)
- Classroom in the Forest
 - Subcategory = Community partner event (what & who)
- Field Day at Extension Center
 - Subcategory = Community partner event (what & who)

6. EXTENSION MASTER GARDENER EDUCATION

Extension Master Gardener Interns' graded assignment to register in the Service Report. Annual CEU's for all Certified Extension Master Gardeners. Training hours for Advanced Extension Master Gardener certification.

Subcategories for entering a report: 1. Extension MG Intern assignment, CEUs, Advanced Extension MG Training.

*This is the ONLY place where drive-time will be counted separately. This prevents exaggerating the statewide annual report of CEU's. When CEUs are part of attending a MGA meeting, the drive time counts along with the volunteer hours of the business meeting portion.

- Educational tour
 - Subcategory = CEU (Date, # CEU Hours, Where, What, *Drive Time)
- Monthly local MGA meeting speaker
 - Subcategory = CEU (Date, # CEU Hours, Where, What)
 - (Note: Drive time to these events is counted in with the business meeting time, under category #7)
- AMGA Annual Conference or AMGA Fall Seminar
 - Subcategory = CEU (Date, # CEU Hours, Where, What, *Drive Time)

7. EXTENSION MASTER GARDENER PROGRAM SUPPORT

Activities that directly support the Extension Master Gardener Program. They are designed to impact Extension and / or an MG association (state or local). These activities help the statewide Extension Master Gardener Program run smoothly.
